

Construction and Demolition Waste Disposal

Disposal of commercial volumes of construction and demolition waste is at Council's temporary landfill site at Goondi Bend Sportsfield for northern areas of the Shire and Bells Creek Waste Transfer Station for the southern end of the Shire. Please endeavour to separate steel from bricks, timber and concrete to assist in recycling efforts. Asbestos must also be separated and bagged prior to disposal at Council's Stoters Hill Waste Transfer Station. Loads which are contaminated with asbestos materials will be treated as asbestos and will not be accepted at Goondi. See below for advice on disposal of asbestos.

The schedule of waste charges is attached. Please note that these fees are subject to variation by Council resolution and reduced rate for construction and demolition wastes (ie sorted building rubble) may be available after 5th April 2006.

You are requested to ensure waste transporters are approved under s369 of the Environmental Protection Act. Application forms for approval are attached. Completed applications should be returned to Council along with the application fee of \$158.00.

Advice for Disposal of Asbestos

Asbestos materials can be taken to Stoters Hill Transfer Station for disposal under the following conditions:

- Asbestos materials should be separated from general construction and demolition wastes.
- Asbestos materials must be double bagged or wrapped.
- Fees must be paid prior to disposal (\$252/cubic metre)
- EPA licensed regulated waste transporters should be used to transport asbestos materials.
